Confidentiality

We guard the information you entrust to us—it's the fine china of your life. All communication between you and your counselor is confidential, unless you (or parent of a minor) give authorization to release it. Exceptions: (1) if you express intent to harm yourself or another, (2) if there is evidence or reasonable suspicion of abuse against a minor, elder person, or dependent adult, or (3) if a subpoena or court order requires disclosure.

Your counselor may consult the Director of Counseling for guidance. Your counselor may seek the wisdom of another counselor within the Center, without the use of your name, in order to seek further wisdom. This collaboration can be an important aspect of the counseling process.
